The senate encourages the university to set up a committee (<u>working group composed of students</u>, <u>faculty</u>, <u>and staff</u>) to study James Madison University's lighting with goal this year to ensure that lighting on campus would **not**:

- 1. shine light upward into the sky where it serves no purpose.
- 2. create glare in our line of sight, or intrude into dorm rooms or natural areas.
- 3. be excessively bright, exceeding recognized industry recommendations.

Improved campus lighting will *improve* safety on campus, conserve energy, save money, improve the beauty of the nocturnal campus, help JMU achieve its goal of being an engaged neighbor in its surrounding community, and serve as a national model of how to light a University campus.
