Evaluate Results

Always do a PIR (post-implementation review)

- Did the scope change
- Which objectives met
- Was it effectively run
- Quantify costs/time
- Team satisfaction
- Customer satisfaction

Discuss:

- Share your last project and any post evaluation.

Identify “Lessons”

Look at what went well and what didn't and learn

- Estimating effort
- Adequate information
- Early successes
- Early/ongoing concerns
- Skills to be developed
- Communicate results

Discuss:

- Which lessons need to be learned often?

Celebrate Success

Find “small” wins and celebrate as you go

- Give one another praise
- Make sure leaders know
- Share results widely
- Reward key players
- Gather together for fun
- Keep a “brag” board

Discuss:

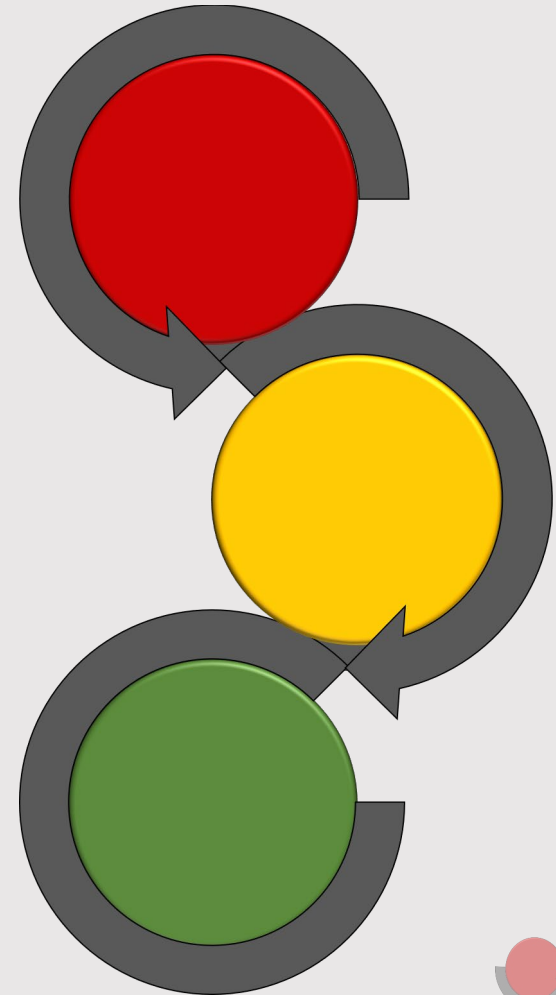
- What do you/your team like to do to celebrate?



Closing: Post Project Debrief

Use the stoplight model (from College of Education)

- What should **NOT** be done again?
(things that were problematic)
- What should we look closely at?
(things that we are not sure about)
- What **SHOULD** be done again?
(things that contribute in a good way)
