## Advising Notes for Sport and Recreation Management

- Sport and Recreation Management is a Bachelor of Science degree; two math courses are required.
- ACTG 244, Accounting for Non-Business majors, is required. There is no equivalent at BRCC, but students may take **both** ACC 211 and ACC 212 as two of their approved electives, and that will waive ACTG 244 once they transfer to JMU.
- SRM majors also earn a minor in General Business.
